 - Senior Scholarships
 - Large percentage of TEMPO's budget goes directly into funding scholarships and awards to Stoga Seniors pursuing music
 - Must be a TEMPO member to qualify for awards/scholarships
 - Scholarships: For graduating TEMPO family seniors pursuing a music-related major at the college level
 - Awards: For graduating TEMPO family seniors continuing music-related activities at the college level (ex. joining the university band, etc)
 - Scholarships/Awards determined by committee (TEMPO, music staff, etc) who review all senior applications and determine award/scholarship levels
 - Dues - \$35 per family

 - TEMPO responsible for: providing roses for Seniors, blocking off Senior parent seating in stadium
- Cavalcade - Stogra Showcase of Sound (Chris Nation, Band Director and Bonnie Filtz-Motel, TEMPO Co-President)
 - 12th Annual
 - biggest event of the year/19 bands competing including Conestoga
 - 3rd largest event in Tredryffrin Township!
 - Major fundraiser for TEMPO
 - program books is a huge part of this (should we get rained out, for example, program book ads ensure that TEMPO at least breaks even and does not lose money)
 - both student and business ads available
 - Ads & Sponsorships/Volunteers - We need YOU!

 - Aprox 200 volunteers required-->all hands on deck!
 - Open Chair Positions
 - Student Volunteers
 - coordinate student volunteer sign-up
 - Work with Cavalcade chairs to staff their needs from student pool

- we have lots of non-band students who volunteer every year
 - Must be on-site day of event
 - Signage Coordinator
 - TEMPO has the signs and the locations they need to be installed at already
 - Coordinator responsible for getting the signs installed ahead of Cavalcade and then making sure they are collected/returned after the event
 - Flow Area Leads
 - Adults required to direct/supervise key areas
 - Bus Parking (lead found)
 - Band Warm-Up area(s), etc
 - Ensure that bands move from one area to another smoothly

 - Money raised goes directly to your student and can be used to pay for TEMPO activities, trips, banquet, etc..
 - On-going Fundraising (Wawa) (portion of Wawa coupon sales to your student's account)
